



ASSIGNMENT: THE LOVE OF OTHERS

Read, “**I Will Do A New Thing**” by Roberta Winter and
“**Imitating Christ in Love and Forgiveness**” by Ron Shaw

Scripture commands us “**in humility consider others better than yourselves.**” (Phil. 2.3)

What person in your life at this time is the hardest for you to “consider better than yourself?”

When you think about this person, how do you react inwardly, feel, think, talk about and treat this person?

Why? Explain why you react to this person as you do. (Did this person sin against you? How?)

How do your emotions drive your thinking and treatment of this person? How would you think about or treat them differently if your feelings were under the control of the Holy Spirit? (Consider especially your personal repentance, forgiveness and/or reconciliation.)

From the message on repentance what can you identify as the 10%, which is your responsibility, (your 100%)?

In light of what you are learning, how can the grace of God change you or affect your relationship with this person?

What steps can you begin to take to consider this person better than yourself? Ask the Lord to help you to be obedient to Him in your relationship to this person.
