#### ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Lord's Supper: Today we will celebrate the Lord's Supper at the end of our morning worship service. This sacrament consists of giving and receiving bread and wine (or juice) to show forth the death of Jesus and receive spiritual nourishment. The Lord's Supper is open to everyone who has confessed their faith in Jesus Christ alone for salvation, provided that they have received Christian baptism, are members in good standing in a Bible believing church, and who are not living with secret or unrepentant sin. If you have any questions about these restrictions then please speak with a pastor or elder after the service, we would love to discuss them with you.

Wednesday Night Prayer Meeting: Join us Wednesdays at 6:00 pm for dinner, followed at 6:45 with a time of prayer, Bible study, children's classes, and nursery.

Regional Shepherding Groups: With the addition of new ruling elders, we have reorganized our Shepherding Groups and created new groups based on geographical area. We have matched members with Shepherding Elders who live in their same geographical area, thus forming regional Shepherding Groups. We drew the boundaries so that each new group includes a ruling elder and deacon (we had to bend or cross a few boundaries to make this work), are somewhat similarly sized, and have dividing lines that follow natural population and geographical boundaries. Our hope is that these new groups will facilitate shepherding care from elders who live nearby, while also taking advantage of relationships among members in the same area.
